The chief of Niagara Regional Police is being saluted by the Friends of Simon Wiesenthal Center for Holocaust Studies.

Jeff McGuire was presented the Award of Tolerance Wednesday night at the <u>FSWC</u>state of the union dinner in Toronto.

The award honour police officers who have most exemplified the values of equality, justice and human rights.

Last year, through the <u>Tour for</u> <u>Humanity</u>, McGuire presented Holocaust survivor Max Eisen to a Welland audience at Niagara College following his tour of

concentration camps and death camps in the Czech Republic and Poland.

The tour's goal is to educate people on the importance of acceptance and tolerance in society. To police, it reinforces the obligation of officers to deliver policing in a bias-free manner, said a news release issued by the NRP.
